**Abstract:**

*This text provides input of pilot research of ideological complex, resulting in hypothetical model of this phenomenon. Methodological procedure is based on combination of both quantitative (1.st phase) and qualitative (in depth interview) procedure used in 2.nd phase of research.*

*Ideological complex represents system of social values. This complex is possible to divide into several components. Orientation of residual component is definable through inclination to the patterns of social equality or inequality. Established level is definable through the positive (SQ+) or negative (SQ-) attitude towards the socially-political system represented as current object of attitude. Rokeach (1973) provides indirect support for the findings. From the view of factor analyses it seems the structure shapes ideological consciousness mainly in the case of relatively strong structural impacts. The existence of several levels into ideological complex provides basis for assumption, the structure shapes ideological consciousness practically always. Discussion relates to theoretical impacts on the problem "structure-consciousness".*
